THE POLITICS OF OBAMACARE: HEALTH CARE, MONEY, AND IDEOLOGY

I. ONE HUNDRED YEARS OF POLITICAL CONTROVERSY

A recent article in *The New Yorker* on the origins of the campaign consulting business provided a fresh reminder—not that one was needed—of how the politics of health care and the politics of politics in the United States are intertwined.¹ *The Lie Factory* described how one of the earliest efforts, by the first two political campaign consultants, was to defeat a 1942 proposal by California Governor Earl Warren to establish a state-run program of health coverage for all of the state's residents.²

For some one hundred years, there has been no more fertile political ground on which to play on people's fear of change than health care. As I write in my book, *Fighting for Our Health: The Epic Battle To Make Health Care a Right in the United States*:
